1-6 Years (recommended annually)

Please remember that this is a wellness schedule. If your pet becomes ill additional tests and diagnostics will be necessary. This schedule will also be modified dependent on your cat's health and lifestyle.

“Senior at Seven”

Pets don't age the way people do—they age much faster. Most pets are considered seniors at seven years of age. Be sure to visit your veterinarian regularly.

7-20 Years (recommended annually)

- ___ Semi-annual physical exam
- ___ Weight/Body Condition
- ___ FVRCP & Rabies vaccine
- ___ FeLV vaccine for at-risk cats
- ___ FeLV/FIV test if at-risk
- ___ Fecal Exam and Deworming
- ___ Wellness Bloodwork
- ___ Dental exam and radiographs
- ___ Nutritional assessment
- ___ Urinalysis
- ___ Thyroid check

Recommended Senior Wellness Tests

- ___ EKG
- ___ Blood Pressure
- ___ Eye Pressure
- ___ Abdominal Radiographs
- ___ Thoracic (chest) Radiographs
- ___ Ultrasound of abdomen & chest
- ___ Skin mass evaluation

Other vaccines are available and can be used as necessary. These include the FIP and Giardia vaccines.
